How do you get an inflammation of the paranasal sinuses (sinusitis)?

Viruses spread in the nose and trigger the cause of the symptoms: inflammation!




The inflammation causes the mucous membranes in the nose to swell and makes breathing difficult. In addition, thicker mucus forms and the nose becomes blocked.



At the same time, the inflammation and mucus spread to the sinuses. This is what causes the unpleasant tension headache.

Sinupret[®] eXtract treats cold-realted sinusitis in two ways: It loosens the congested mucus and reduces swelling of the inflamed mucous membranes.

Dosage

1 tablet 3 times a day, does not need to be taken with meals.

Helpful tips for a blocked nose



How to blow your nose "properly"!

Do not blow your nose too hard and only blow one side of the nose at a time! The right way is: Press one nostril shut, blow the other and then change sides. Make sure you do not blow too hard as this could force the secretion into the sinuses. The nose is gently cleared of mucus.



Make sure to drink enough water!

This compensates for water loss (e.g. if you have a temparture) and helps loosen the mucus.



Raise the head of your bed by about 20°!

Helps relieve a blocked nose. Enables you to get a restful sleep despite having a cold and sinusitis.



Fresh air!

To increase humidity in the room, you can hang damp cloths over the heating, for example. If the humidity is too low, the mucous membranes of the airway dry out. Bacteria and viruses are able to enter more easily.



When should I take which medication?

Of course, decongestant nasal sprays also offer temporary relief for a blocked nose, e.g. for a better sleep. You should not use these for more than a few days, however, because there is a risk of tolerance developing. To thoroughly and effectively treat a blocked nose, Sinupret[®] eXtract is recommended.
