Common Colds – why the little ones catch them so often

Children's immune systems still need to learn.

Children catch a cold up to eight times a year and therefore suffer from a blocked nose far more often than adults. The reason for this is that a child's immune system is not fully developed. Bacteria and viruses therefore find it particularly easy to get a foothold in small children.

Watch out! - From a common cold to a middle ear infection

When you have a cold, viruses and bacteria adhere to the mucous membranes of the nose and throat. These pathogens can travel to the middle ear, as the throat and middle ear are connected to each other by a fine passage, the Eustachian tube. In children, in particular, this tube is still very short and narrow. A simple cold or infection can therefore quickly move to the middle ear.

For this reason, it is important to loosen the congested mucus early, reduce inflammation of the nasal mucosa and thereby ensure that the middle ear has sufficient aeration again. Targeted and lasting support is needed for a stuffy cold.

Additional tips for treating colds -How your child can get better faster



Fresh air is important

Warm air from heating dries out the mucous membranes of the airways. This makes them susceptible to bacteria and viruses. Regularly opening windows for short periods ensures oxygen-rich fresh air. To increase humidity, place a bowl of water on the heater or hang damp cloths in the room.



Have plenty to drink

Ensure your children have adequate fluid intake. This prevents the mucous membranes from drving out.



Do not overheat!

Feet warm, head cool. Take care not to dress your child too warmly. Choose breathable clothing. Wearing layers is the best way to adjust to changing temperatures.



Blow your nose - but how?

Blowing your nose properly is important. Take care that your child does not blow too hard if their nose is blocked. The right way is to press one nostril closed and blow the other, then change nostrils. This avoids too much pressure which could possibly force the secretion into the sinuses. The nose is gently cleared of mucus



Tip

Before blowing the nose, carefully remove the crusty mucus with a damp cotton bud or soft cloth. If the nose is already inflamed, use mild
